



Worship with us on a Sunday

Traditional Service at 8.30 am

For those who prefer something a little quieter and contemplative, these services are 'said' (no singing) with Holy Communion on the first and third Sundays and Morning Prayer on the second and fourth Sundays. Service leaders are usually robed and the service lasts for 45 mins.



Family Worship at 10.30 am

A contemporary service, with extended worship led by our band with in-depth Bible teaching. We follow our Home Group sermon series and enjoy seasonal and special events alongside regular guest speakers. Holy Communion usually takes place on the second and fourth Sundays.

First Sunday: All Age Worship/Parade Service (60 - 75 mins)

Children and Adults stay together for the whole service
We also enjoy occasional Café Style services with breakfast!

Other Sundays: with Sunday School (75 - 90 mins)

We worship together as a church family for about 15 minutes before Heroes (Primary aged school children) and Trinity Tribe (Lower Secondary) leave for their groups. A supervised crèche is available.

On the third Sunday we have **Messy Church** at 10.00 am for families and this takes place in the church hall. The 10.30 am service will Continue as normal without Heroes or Trinity Tribe.

Fifth Sunday: The Billericay & Little Burstead Team Ministry

Worship together at 10.00 am at Christ Church or Emmanuel.



Evening Worship

We don't have an evening service, as such, but we do enjoy occasional services and/or special events, including an Alpha Course at Saint Mary Magdalen 'The Church in the High Street'. We meet bi-monthly with Churches Together in Billericay, on the third Sunday evening at 6.30 pm, for 'Prayer & Praise' shared around Billericay Churches.
